Moti Sonnenfeld Visits Faculty, Grants Scholarships

On December 8, 2024, Moti Sonnenfeld (pictured to left) visited the Azrieli Faculty of Medicine in Safed. Moti Sonnenfeld is the founder of the Danielle Sonnenfeld Foundation, named after his daughter Danieli, who was tragically killed in a car accident some 10 years ago. I completed both my master's and doctoral degrees in Prof. Moshe Dessau's lab. I began at the faculty in 2015, right after earning my bachelor's degree in Biotechnology Engineering. I completed my PhD in 2022. Currently, I am pursuing a postdoctoral fellowship at Harvard Medical School in Dr. Melissa Leger-Abraham's lab. The lab focuses on studying the structurefunction relationships of proteins from a wide range of disease-causing parasites, such as Plasmodium (the causative agent of malaria).

The most significant skills I developed during my graduate studies are research-oriented thinking and understanding the importance of collaboration. Problem-solving abilities—honed through logic and creativity, both individually and in teams—are akin to a muscle that requires daily training. Over time, this process becomes more organic and evolves into a way of life. I believe problem-solving skills are invaluable both inside and outside the lab.
