# Spotlight on Research

### The End of the Antibiotic Era

The Clinical Microbiology, Immunology and Infectious Diseases Research Laboratory, headed by Professor Avi Peretz, investigates infectious diseases that are the most common in hospitals and particularly in the Galilee, caused by bacteria such has Clostridioides difficile and Helicobacter pylori (H. pylori). We characterize bacterial virulence factors and antibiotic resistance, and host's immune response to pathogens and develop rapid methods for bacterial identification in clinical samples.


causes chronic gastritis and is prevalent in ~50% of world population. There is a great challenge in this bacterium treatment due to its high antibiotic resistance rates, and this is the reason why the world health organization included H. pylori in the list of bacteria with high priority for antibiotic research and development. Since the bacterium is difficult-to-culture, there is a limited data on antibiotic resistance and treatment, which includes 3-4 antibiotics, is

One investigated bacterium is H. pylori, which

Our recent study screened 540 isolates who were recovered from gastric biopsies during 2015-2020, and found high resistance rates to clarithromycin (46.3%) and metronidazole (16.3%) that are both a first-line treatment. There was a significant increase in resistance rates of levofloxacin and metronidazole during the years. Additionally, resistance rates to some antibiotics were higher among bacteria recovered from Arab population, as compared to Jewish population. The study indicate on the importance of monitoring resistance, the need for guidelines

update and the urgent need for new treatments.


